



ARCTIC BLAST SNOW CAMP PARENT PACKET

Welcome to our incredible Arctic Blast Snow Camp! We are so excited that you have signed up your teen to attend this incredible weekend of camp! We are sure they are going to have an unforgettable time here as they explore our winter wonderland, get involved in our program games, build relationships with other teens and their counselors, and most importantly learn about Jesus Christ and His love for them.

We send you this letter to inform you of what to expect with the approaching weekend of camp and its registration process. We hope this letter will answer any questions you may have but feel free to contact us if you still have questions that are unanswered or if you are confused by our instructions.

- REGISTRATION -

We hope to make the registration process as simple as possible for you. There are a few things you should accomplish before you come so that the process will be easier when you get here.

- Fill out forms. Please log back into your CampInTouch account (the account you used to submit the application) and complete the following forms. They need to be completed for your child to come to camp. Completing them before you come to registration will make the process easier and faster for you.
 - The Health History Form (an online form)
 - The General Release of Liability (needs to be printed, then uploaded, mailed, or faxed)
 - The Horse Release of Liability (needs to be printed, then uploaded, mailed, or faxed)
- Get paid up. If there is any outstanding balance when you come to registration, it must be paid then. You can finish your payments beforehand online or by mail to make registration easier for you.
- Have medications ready to give to the nurse. All medications your child may need throughout the weekend must be in their original containers and given to the nurse. Have it ready as you go through the registration process.
- Snack Shack funds. Have cash ready to deposit into the snack shack during registration. Funds can also be deposited online through your CampInTouch account prior to registration.
- Check for lice. Here at River of Life Camp, we have a "No Nit" Policy. In order to stop the spread of lice to other campers, we do not allow campers to come if there are any signs of lice on them.

For forms that you wish to fax, the number can be found at the bottom of that form, near the barcode. Forms or payments (such as checks) that you wish to mail can be sent to our physical address at the bottom of this letter. Please do not send forms or checks in the mail any sooner than one week prior to the start of camp. If you have sent your child to camp here before, you just need to update the Health History form online.

Again, we want registration to be a smooth, simple process for you. Help us accomplish this by completing as many of these things as you can before the first day of camp!

- DROP OFF/PICK UP -

We hope your child is getting excited to be here! We encourage you to be on time when dropping off your child. We would not want them to miss anything! If for some reason you cannot make it here during our scheduled registration time, please give us a call and we would love to work with you.

- Registration begins at 5:00PM and ends at 5:45PM on Friday.
- Campers will be ready with their stuff at the church building for pick up at 1:00PM on Sunday.
